Why do a short-term missions trip?

Reason #2 - Clarity on what happens with people serving in other countries. Each community and culture has unique challenges to serving in it. It's one thing to talk about those challenges ... entirely different to get up close and see those challenges first hand. Being informed at this level gives trip participants the ability to be more informed advocates when they return home.
